

Laura L. Arrowsmith, DO earned her Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree from the Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences in 1977. She completed a rotating internship at Riverside Hospital in Wichita, KS, and radiology residency at Oklahoma State University Medical School. From 1981-1985, Dr. Arrowsmith served the United States Navy as an active duty radiologist and chief of radiology services

at the U.S. Navy Hospital in Orlando, Florida. A board-certified radiologist and diplomat of the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners, she has since practiced in Washington, Florida, Iowa, and, most recently, Bartlesville, OK, and Tulsa, OK. In 2012, she entered the OSU-Tulsa counseling psychology master's program. Founder and CEO of Transgender Training and Education, LLC, Dr. Arrowsmith is a teacher and advocate for the transgender community. She has volunteered as director of Transgender Programs at Oklahomans for Equality and currently serves on the National Center for Transgender Equality Board of Directors. She is also a physician advisor for Heartland Division of Planned Parenthood regarding transgender medical care. Dr. Arrowsmith is a member of the American Osteopathic College of Radiology, American Osteopathic Association, World Professional Association for Transgender Health and the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association.
